

## Gain Capital Broadens Forex Access With Extra Tools

NEW YORK – New Jersey-based Gain Capital, an online currency trading system aimed at retail and institutional investors, is set to include analytics, charts and FX news from partnership sites.

Glen Stevens, head of sales and marketing at Gain in New Jersey says the expansion is in response to a proliferation of retail traders and smaller hedge funds which have recently entered the FX market to capitalise on recent volatility in Asian currencies and the euro.

Stevens says these tools will enable retail and smaller hedge fund investors to trade for the first time with a comprehensive analysis of what's happening in the market. These tools were previ-

ously only available to traders and salespeople at major financial institutions, he says.

Gain's new service will have a single access point to all the partnership sites at a discount to their clients. The new sites consist of eight analytics sites: New York-based Primark Decision Economics, provider of global indicators that affect currency markets; London-based Nostradamus, market information provider; International Financial Review, which provides technical analysis on FX spot and options; chorek.com, which provides market commentary; London-based economic consultancy firm 4CastWeb; London-based Pronet Analytics; New Zealand-based

KB Advisory, which provides technical advice on all major currencies, and New Zealand-based Technical Research Limited, which provides analysis of currency performance.

Colorado-based Aspen Graphics provides charts, and there is an FX news service from New York-based MoneyLine.

Gain's core service remains its dealing software, which it says is the fastest ever FX processing system.

Gain is also planning an educational program for retail investors wishing to start trading FX.

As part of this, the website contains lists of books about trading in currency markets and mastering technical analysis.
